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ELENA BAJO

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Elena Bajo is an artist, educator, choreographer and founder of the P-A-D Project, Wonder Valley in the Californian desert, dedicated to ecological activism. Her multidisciplinary practice investigates ideas of space, nature, and the body as a political and social entity questioning its relationship to ecologies of capital. Using ancestral methods and her multidisciplinary art practice she mines vibrant plant systems in order to discover their unique form of consciousness. Her focus is on the research and recuperation of ancestral ethno-botanical ontologies. She works both individually and collectively, using choreography, sculpture, performance, painting, poetry, and video.

She received an MFA from Central Saint Martins, (London, UK) and an MA in Genetic Architecture from ESARQ UIC (Barcelona, ES), studied Laban and Bartenieff Movement at TanzFabrik, Berlin Contemporary Dance Center. She has presented performances, exhibited and taught internationally. She also received support, grants and residencies from LMCC Art Center, Governors Island NY, US 2023; Rauschenberg EMGrants, 2022; NARS Studio Relief, 2022: Matadero Madrid Residency, A/CE ES for EKWC European Ceramic Work Center, NL, 2021; Hopper Prize 2020; NY Contemporary Art Foundation Emergency Grant 2019; Botín Foundation, Visual Arts Fellowship Award, ES 2018; Audemars Piguet Award, ARCOMadrid, ES 2017.

The Madrid- and New York-based artist Elena Bajo uses generative AI to create her work *Words Buried in Your Petals (Datura Dreams)*. Two works make up this project and will be exhibited at the gallery. The first is *An Exhortation of the Cheater*, 2023. These uncomfortably beautiful textiles are woven with a Jacquard loom—an early algorithmic method of weaving, invented in the nineteenth century, that Bajo has appropriated for these quasi-sculptures. Under the self-induced hallucinogenic effects of the indigenous plant Datura, Bajo first fabricates her work by hand, assembling abstract fragments of found textiles into preliminary works. These are then digitally photographed, and the data thus produced is fed into Google Deep Dream, which outputs them in a new form: as anamorphic, suspended, textile works that are composed of a multiplicity of multicolored whorls or eyes. This “software surrealism” is the result of the twenty-first century transmateriality (as Karan Barad has described that concept in her book *Transmaterialities*) of human, animal, and digital-machinic consciousness. Bajo’s work is a psychedelic experiment that poses the question: Can one induce a “trip” in a machine? The second work is entitled *A Space to Reign* (2013–23) and is composed of hand-crafted Datura Stramonium seeds cast in 24 karat gold situated beneath a divinatory crystal ball. The crystal ball contains a variety of other materials—glass, mirror, ceramic fragments, light, plant parts, fabric scraps and soil—through which the seeds can be inspected. Situated at three locations in the gallery, these divinatory sculptures operate as central nodes in networks of aesthetic and shamanistic forecasting. A planned performative reading of a poem written by Bajo entitled “Devil’s Trumpet a Predicament of the Fool” will reactivate the installation.

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



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

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Elena Bajo - Anarchische Anarchive

ELENA BAJO verwebt in ihrer künstlerischen Praxis auf komplexe Weise Kunst, Politik und Leben. Die Künstlerin vertritt eine universelle Definition des Feminismus und schafft inklusive Räume und Kunstwerke, in denen sich Menschen, Tiere und Pflanzen finden und in denen das Kognitive, das Spirituelle und das Körperliche gleichermaßen präsent sind.

Die Basis der Arbeit von ELENA BAJO ist Anarchie als grundsätzliche geistige und moralische Haltung: „Anarchie ist [...] eine radikale und kritische Wahrnehmung deiner Umgebung, die sich gegen das Etablierte richtet. Sie nährt sich aus dem Glauben, jeden zu respektieren und jedem sein Daseinsrecht zuzugestehen: Menschen, Tieren und Pflanzen. Es ist die Affirmation des Lebenden. In ihrem Kern ist sie kritisch gegenüber jeglicher Form von Macht und Unterdrückung.“

Elena Bajo - Anarchistic anarchive

In her artistic practice, ELENA BAJO interweaves art, politics and life in a complex web. The artist represents a universal definition of feminism and creates inclusive spaces and artworks occupied by people, animals and plants, in which cognitive, spiritual and physical elements are present in equal measure.

ELENA BAJO's work is based on anarchy as a fundamental mindset and moral stance: “Anarchy is [...] a radical and critical perception of one’s environment, directed against established norms. It feeds on the belief that everyone should be respected and has a right to exist – people, animals and plants alike. It is the affirmation of the living. At its core, it is critical of any form of power and oppression.”

Ausgehend von dieser Grundeinstellung befasst sich ELENA BAJO mit Themen wie Raum, Politik, Feminismus oder ökologischem Bewusstsein. Den Referenzrahmen ihrer Installationen, Skulpturen und Performances bilden zumeist Texte oder andere Wissensquellen, die Eingang in ein Manifest finden, welches auf vorangegangenen Projekten aufbauend weiter wächst. Neben anarchistischen und feministischen Schriften rekurriert sie z.B. auf alternative Wissensformen und Praktiken, spirituelle Traditionen oder Paradigmen des ökologischen Aktivismus.

Konkreter Ausgangspunkt ihrer Werke ist der spezifische architektonische Raum, in dem ELENA BAJO jede ihrer Ausstellungen komponiert. Dabei bringt sie Objekte und Materialien, Körper und andere Akteure in einen nicht hierarchischen Zusammenhang. Zugleich verwebt sie Themen wie Arbeit, sozioökonomische Fragestellungen und magische Rituale mit Körpern, Performances und Materialien. Sie nennt dieses besondere Element ihrer künstlerischen Praxis „Anarchive“.

Weil sie ihre Arbeit als Prozess auffasst, in dem sich das Werk in einem ständigen Zustand des Entstehens und Neuverhandelns befindet, bezeichnet ELENA BAJO ihre Arbeitsweise als „Un-Choreographing“. Ihre Kompositionen aus Bewegungen und Körpern nennt sie „Anarchoreographien“, deren Bewegungsrichtungen nicht hierarchisch zu lesen sind und das Verständnis von Subjektivität und Kollektivität als konstantes Fließen im Raum vermitteln. Oft integriert sie auch schamanistische Riten und alchemistische Prozesse, weil diese besondere Veränderungen herbeiführen können: „This is essential to my work: anarchists, witches and artists share this desire for change.“

Based on this outlook, ELENA BAJO explores themes such as space, politics, feminism and environmental awareness. The frame of reference used in her installations, sculptures and performances is generally composed of texts or other sources of knowledge, cut up into a Manifesto text that accumulates from previous projects. Besides anarchistic and feminist writings, she references alternative forms of knowledge and practices, spiritual traditions or paradigms of environmental activism.

The concrete starting point of ELENA BAJO's works is the specific architectural space in which she composes each of her exhibitions. In doing so, she brings together objects and materials, bodies and other players in a non-hierarchical context. At the same time, she interweaves themes such as work, socio-economic questions and magic rituals with bodies, performances and materials. She calls this unique element of her artistic practice “anarchive”.

Because she sees her work as a process in which the artwork is in a constant state of generation and renegotiation, ELENA BAJO describes her approach as “un-choreographing” which translates into her way of composing with movement and bodies, what she calls “anarchoreographies”, non hierarchical trajectories used as a tool to articulate a sense of subjectivity and collectivity and the creation of a space in constant flux. In addition, she often integrates shamanistic rites and alchemical processes because these can give rise to particular changes: “This is essential to my work: anarchists, witches and artists share this desire for change.”

In ihren minimalistischen Arbeiten spielt das Material (z.B. Wellpappe, Stoff, Zement, Steine, Glas, Pflanzen) eine zentrale Rolle. Aufgeladen mit Bedeutung bildet es eine Brücke zu den Referenzen und Theorien, soll zugleich aber auch für sich stehen und verstanden werden können. Hier lotet die Künstlerin den Widerspruch aus: Zu entmaterialisieren und minimalistisch zu arbeiten, dabei dem Material dennoch so viel Raum einzustehen, dass mit möglichst wenig Gesten viel Wirkung erzielt wird.

Für diese Ausstellung entwickelt ELENA BAJO ein Konzept, das unerwartete Blickwinkel auf Trinkwasserverschmutzung durch Medikamente und Plastikpartikel einnimmt. Rückstände, die durch illegal oder legal abgeleitete Arzneistoffe aus Haushalten und der Pharmaindustrie stammen, können durch farblich unterschiedene Testverfahren nachgewiesen werden. Solche Prozesse und damit zusammenhängende Materialien interpretiert sie im Hinblick auf utopische Szenarien, die sowohl zukünftige archäologische Forschungen, als auch spirituelle Handlungen sowie die Wiederverwertung pharmazeutisch wirksamer Substanzen z.B. in Hydrokulturen einbeziehen.

In her minimalist works, the material (e.g. corrugated board, fabric, cement, stones, glass, plants) plays a central role. Loaded with significance, it builds a bridge to the references and theories, but should also be capable of making an impact and being understood in its own right. Here, the artist plumbs the depths of the inherent contradiction: dematerialising and working minimalistically yet allowing the material enough space for it to maximise its impact with a minimum of gestures.

For the TRIPLE EXPANSION exhibition, ELENA BAJO is developing a concept that analyses unexpected perspectives on pharmaceutical and plastic pollutants in tap water that come from legal and illegal drugs flushed down the toilet or from discarded industrial wastewater. She interprets the detection of such toxic residues by the means of laboratory reagents as a starting point for speculations about their possible role in future archeological research or spiritualism, or in utopian scenarios of drugs' recycling and hydroponics.
